




HOW TO SELL ON ETSY


This tutorial assumes the user has an Etsy account and profile.

Instructions


Navigate to https://www.etsy.com/. You will be taken to the homepage of the website as shown below.




Scroll to the bottom of the page and look for "Sell". Click on "Sell on Etsy".




• You will be taken to a page that contains more information about setting up a shop on Etsy. Scroll to the middle of the page and click on "Selling".



• You will be taken to a page that shows what you can sell on Etsy. Click on the "Open your Etsy Shop" button.



• There will be a pop up to sign in. Log into your account.




 You will be redirected to a page to set up your shop. Follow the instructions and fill out any relevant information on the page.




• The first portion is "Shop Preferences". Select the language, country and currency. Select an option that describes you best. Once all the fields are filled out, the "Save and Continue" button will turn black - you can click to navigate to the next page.

Shop preferences

Let's get started! Tell us about you and your shop.



 Select a name for your shop. It should be unique and available. Type the name in and check availability



If a name is not available, you will see the "Not Available" box in red and be given alternate names. If the name is available, you will see an orange "Available" button. You can now Save and Continue to the next page.



Your shop name will appear in your shop and next to each of your listings throughout Etsy. After you open your shop, you can change your name once. Here are some tips for picking a shop name.

The next page, "Stock Your Shop", allows you to take pictures and add a listing. Click on "Add a listing" to add more and relevant information about the items you wish to sell. Add as much information as possible including pictures, details, or even a video. This will help the buyer know more information about the product you wish to sell.

Add as many listings as you can. Ten or more would be a great start. More listings means more chances to be discovered!



Add a new listing

Photos

Add as many as you can so buyers can see every detail.

Use up to ten photos to show your item's most important qualities.

- · Use natural light and no flash.
- · Include a common object for scale.
- Show the item being held, worn, or used.
- Shoot against a clean, simple background.

Link photos to variations

Add photos to your variations so buyers can see all their options. Try it out

























• Fill out all the relevant details of the listing including category, size, color etc. This helps shoppers find the item in the relevant category.




 Once all the details including inventory and pricing as well as shipping information are filled out, you can preview the shop.




 Add as many listing as you want - the more listings the better. Once all the listings are added, click on Save and Continue.



 The next page is "How You'll Get Paid". Fill out your bank information and other relevant information to set up transfers. Information will include banking info (account number and routing number), address, phone number etc.



 Before completing the billing portion, you will need to upload an official government identification document.




- If you haven't confirmed your email address, you might get a prompt to complete this step.
- The final step is to add a form of payment for any Etsy billing. Make sure to review any and all associated fees before setting up shop. Learn more about fees here: https://www.etsy.com/legal/fees
