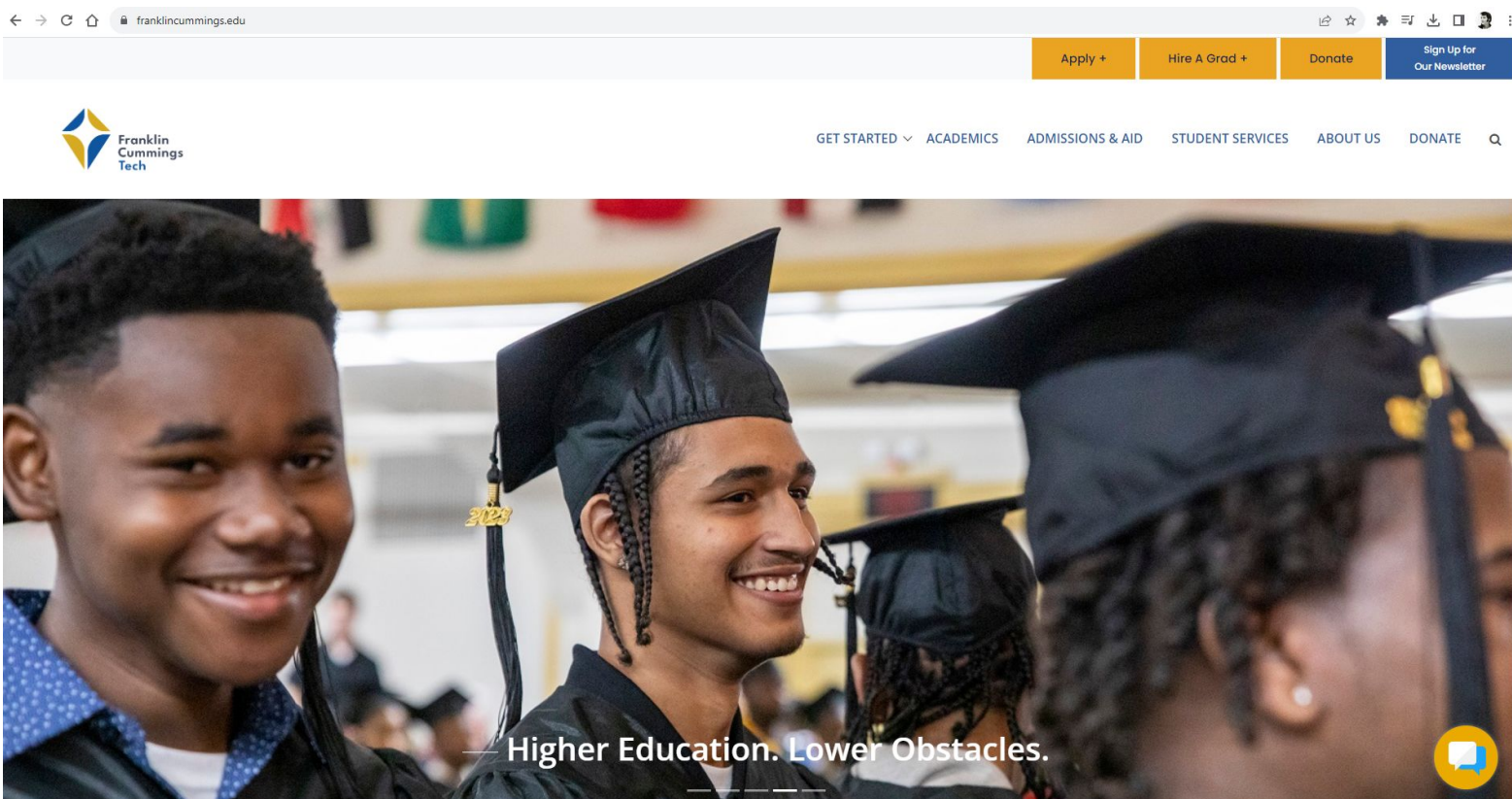

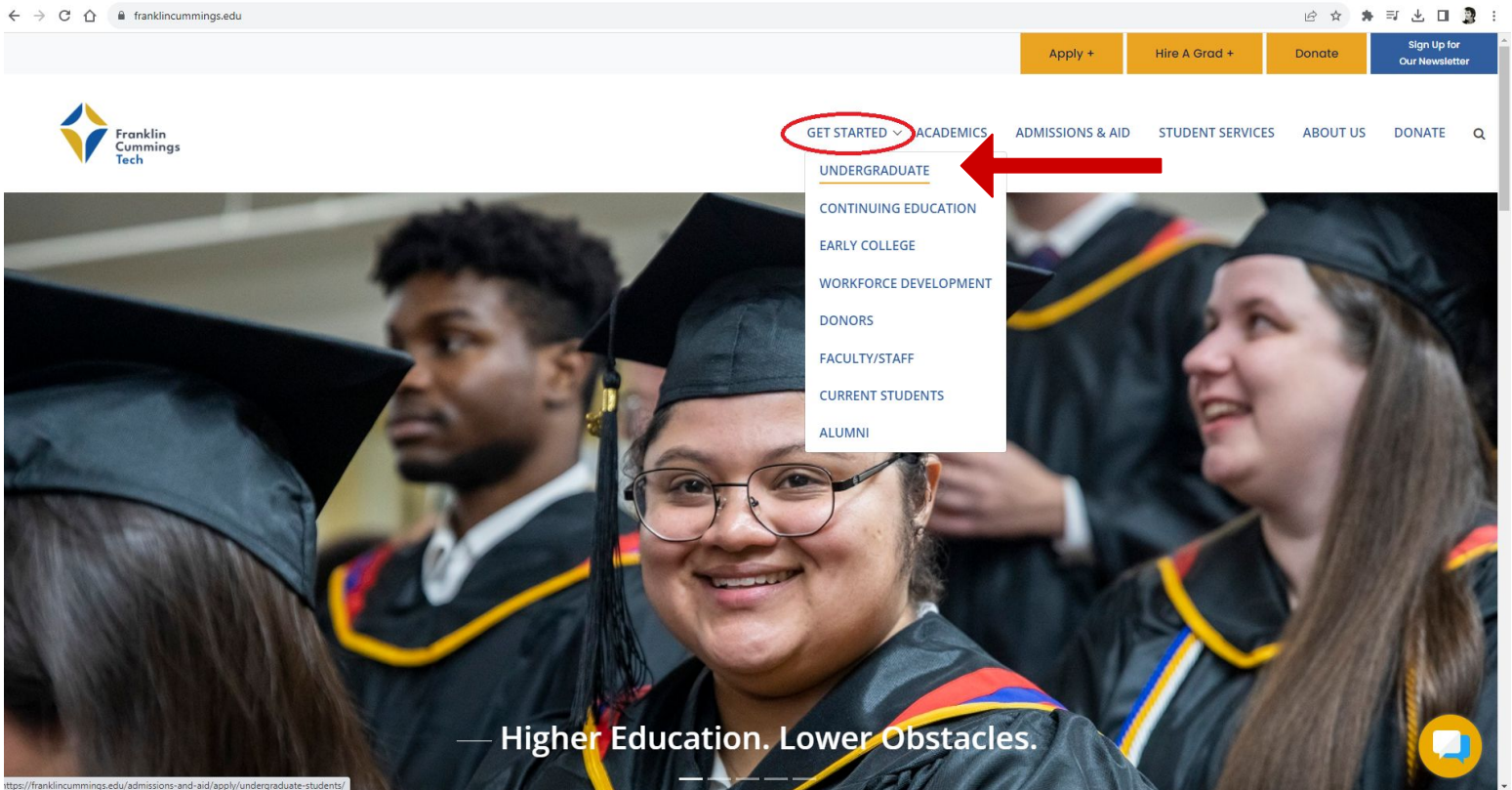

Instructions

- First, go to the link of the website that is provided here [Franklin Cummings Tech](https://franklincummings.edu/) or type in this URL in a new google chrome tab <https://franklincummings.edu/>
- You will then be brought to the front page of this website shown below



- Hover over the “Get Started” tab at the top of the website(circled in red) and then click on the “Undergraduate tab” to get started with your application



- Before getting started, If you are still considering whether to apply right now or later, you can scroll down the page further to see the benefits of applying to the school early

Fall 2024 Early Action Priority Program

Secure your place in our Fall 2024 class by applying through our Early Action Priority Program.

Simply submit our online application by **Friday, December 8, 2023**. (Once accepted, you must submit your Acceptance Response Form and your FAFSA by February 16, 2024 to qualify for Early Action benefits.)

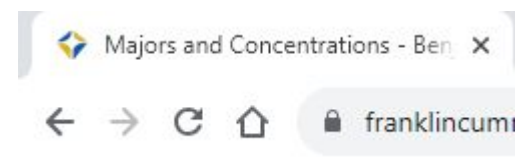

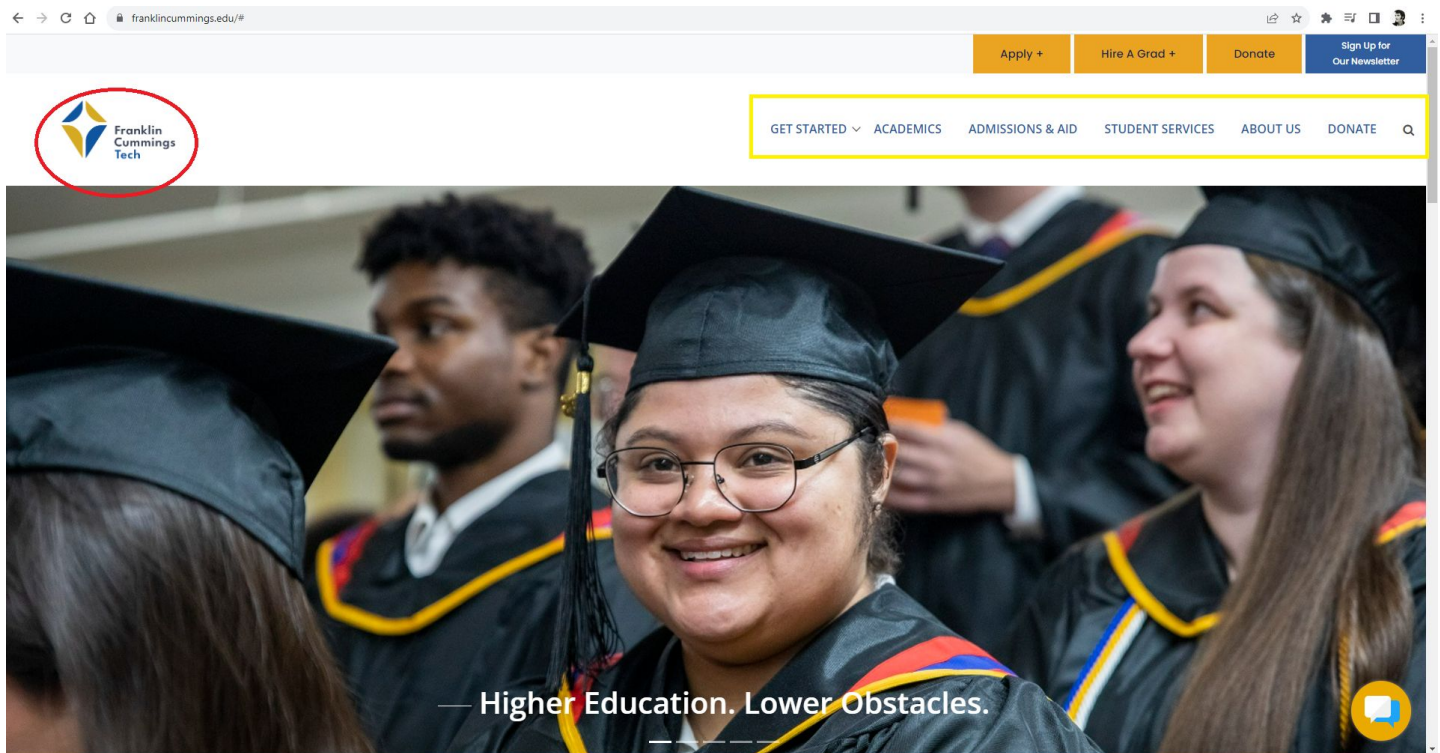
