




Practice your mousing skills with Mousercise!!!

Next you'll be asked to click a specific number in a set of numbers. This is where you become familiar with the hand shape that the cursor turns into. And it will look like this



Time for some precision clicking. Click the number 9 in the center below to continue, but be careful not to click the surrounding 3's, or you will be sent back to page 3!

(Hint: when your mouse cursor turns to the hand shape, place the tip of the finger in the middle of the link you want to click)

Again, you'll want to look for that hand shape. This teaches you how to know what text is an actual link.

Text links can appear in many visual styles. Sometimes the only way to determine if text is a link is by placing your mouse cursor on top of it and looking to see if the cursor changes to a hand shape.

One of the words below is a link. Place your mouse cursor on each word and look for the hand shape. When you find the word that is a link, go ahead and click on it.

Next you'll learn about the different kinds of buttons you can click.

Many times you will have to click on buttons, which can appear in many different styles. Click the button below to continue.

Images that don't even look like buttons can also be links. Find the image below that is a link and click on it. (Hint: look for the mouse cursor changing to the hand shape when on top of the link.)

Click each of the buttons below to advance to the next page.




Next is the double click. When you're double clicking you need to do it fast or else the mouse won't recognize it as a double click. You'll notice if you double click too slow the firecrackers won't blow up. Practice and notice the difference between two clicks and a double click.

Double-click each of the firecrackers below to set them off, then continue to the next page.



We have now moved on to a “click and drag”. To properly click and drag you’re going to click the mouse and keep your finger pressed down while moving/dragging the mouse. Give it some practice here by clicking and dragging the tabs down.

Click and drag the slider tabs down and up to change the background color of this page. When you are done, click the 'Continue' link.

Use the scroll bar on the right side of the window to scroll to the bottom of this page.



On this page you’ll learn how to scroll. Depending on the kind of mouse you own scrolling will be different. Laptop touchpads work differently than an actual mouse. You may need to Google your specific mouse if you are having trouble.

And this section teaches you how to scroll to the side.

Use the scroll bar at the bottom of this window to scroll the page over to the right side.
